We aspire to provide a nurturing, supportive and connected learning environment in order to empower students with 21st century skills. The community at LTMHS believes that students learn best when they are connected, provided with authentic learning experiences, and are prepared to succeed in a complex, interconnected, and ever-changing world. At LTMHS, we pride ourselves on giving students the most opportunities possible to work with technology with a 1:1 technology integration program which has become a model for other schools seeking to adopt a similar program.
