The building, with sections renovated in 2006, is well kept and offers well-lit classrooms, a large playground, a moderately sized gymnasium with stage, a lab and science room, two staffrooms, a workshop, a recently updated library, and a cafeteria where the caterer serves homemade meals every day. We offer remediation support during school hours, a variety of extra-curricular activities including sports, social and scientific clubs, art and even wood working. The school also organizes many outdoor activities, some teambuilding, camping/canoeing overnight trips. The school has access to many of the municipality's facilities: parks, beaches, ice rinks, arena and pool.



Sports teams for girls and boys: Basketball, volleyball, soccer, football, skiing.


